#### *Our Self-Evaluation Report on Wellbeing*

Sa scoilbhliain dár tús Meán Fómhair 2021 , d'fhéachamar ar chúrsaí folláine inár scoil chun a fháil amach cad atá á dhéanamh go maith againn.

*During the academic year commencing in September 2021, we explored wellbeing in our school to identify what we are doing well.*

Seo an t-eolas a fuairamar amach: *This is what we discovered:*

- Is scoil chairdiúil í Scoil Chearbhaill Uí Dhálaigh ina gcuirtear fáilte roimh an comhphobal ina iomláine.
- Bíonn an timpeallacht glan agus néata.
- Braitheann comhphobal na scoile sábháilte ar scoil agus aithníonn na daltaí an dlúthchairdeas atá eatarthu. Chomh maith leis sin tá tuiscint acu ar an gcóras scoile chun dul i ngleic le buarthaí maidir le bulaíocht.
- Léiríonn na baill éagsúla de chomhphobal na scoile meas ar a chéile.
- Aithnítear éifeacht na gcóras cumarsáide atá in úsáid sa scoil. Tugann foireann na scoile tacaíocht ar ard-chaighdeán do na daltaí ar bhonn shóisialta, acadúil, mothúcháin agus iompair.

***We will focus on the following areas:***

- Ainmneacha an Duine Idirchaidrimh Ainmnithe (DIA) agus an Duine Idirchaidrimh Ainmnithe Tánaisteach (DIAT) a shoiléiriú do na tuismitheoirí de réir ár Ráiteas Um Chumhdach Leanaí
- Cé go dtuigeann na páistí an próiséas scoile atá i bhfeidhm maidir le tacaíocht foirne a lorg maidir le deacrachtaí i suíomhanna sóisialta, níl an rannpháirtíocht sa chleachtas ar chomhleibhéal leis an túsicint.
- Soiléiriú a dhéanamh maidir leis gcóras bainistíochta a bhaineann le soláthar Oideachais Speisialta sa scoil.
- Féachfar ar bhealaí chun inchur na ndaltaí a fháil maidir le beartas agus gníomhaíochta scoile a chur i bhfeidhm.

- *To place a larger emphasis on Healthy Foods in all classes.*

***School time and holidays***

Cuireann an Roinn de cheangal ar na bunscoileanna uile **183 lá scoile** a bheith acu gach bliain. I mbliana beidh 183 lá scoile againn, ón 31 Lúnasa 2021 go dtí 30 Meitheamh.2022
